Old Business:

Memberships/Renewals: 529 current members + 3 in the queue = 532

Motion made to go digital. Butch and Clyde opposed.

Motion made to open the range starting in April, for 25 new members/month for four months. We'll evaluate each month to see how close we're getting to 700 members. Phil opposed.

Bank Balance: \$93,196.21 as of today. Taxes are done.

Scout troop activities. Refer to email from John Price.

Tree removal update. Four trees cut down in pistol pits and three behind score shack.

Shot in berms at pistol range. No further discussion required.

300-yard rifle target idea. Butch said it won't happen. Also, the settlement agreement says if we expand the range, we have to do it step-by-step.

Update on new shed project. We paid \$11K for it last year. The price of lumber just increased so if we were to buy it today, it would cost \$14K. A month from now we'll have a new steel shed.

Update on Bay 5 shelter. West Coast Metals seems to be incompetent. Jeremy will look for a new supplier for a metal prefab.

New dueling tree in Bay 5. It's already in place and works really well. A member built it for us.

Resuming pistol and rifle matches. Pistol matches have already resumed. Rifle match will resume in April. IWL Ladies matches will resume in May.

Fix road. Clyde will get a bid.

Donations. Let each of us bring a non-profit we'd like to donate to, to the next meeting.

Youth shoots. Ruger will donate another gun, and a benefactor will donate another one. Each event will run from 9 am to 12 noon. Considering holding these shoots in July and August. We're buying the ammo: \$800 for 15,000 rounds.
