No Progress was made on installing the audibles for the rifle range.

Project update on scooping out the silt from the french drains and pushing back erosion onto berms: The work is almost done. We need to re dig the drains and put in erosion control on the hillside.

Parking lot project update: Garl is still playing phone tag with the companies. The approximate price is \$75 per rubber curb and we would need 30-40 of them. Garl will need to look at the parking map to determine how many we actually need as well as get an accurate quote. Garl will be able to pick them up with the use of the IWLA Trailer. After they are in place we will need to install them with rebar and SDS drill.

The 200 yard berm is functional and much improved. We will put 2-3 more loads of dirt to finish off the work.

Northwest Precision came to the meeting and brought an example of the emergency sheet with instructions, address and directions to the range for EMS, they also offered to hang up 5 trauma kits at the bays. In regards to the concerns we have with NWP operating at the range we voted to address these concerns at the November BOD meeting as this meeting is primarily about planning the all member meeting coming up on October 26th.
